

The Christmas Holiday Lunch Scheme enrolments are now open.

We are inviting families with school-aged children (who live or attend a school in the city of Winchester and some surrounding areas, including Alresford) who feel they need some extra help over the school holidays to register for our Holiday Lunch Scheme. The aim of the scheme is to provide food to cover 5 lunches per child per week. Please note that the holiday lunch scheme is in addition to our normal operation, and does not count towards the number of standard vouchers you can receive. However, we ask that you don't claim both during the same period of time.

Please be aware that the food supplied is designed to replace the hot meal and will be tinned/dried; we do not have food items suitable for packed lunch style meals.

The standard content for this year's Christmas bag will be the following items: Penne pasta, chicken noodles, tomato pasta sauce, a big soup with meat, baked beans, spaghetti hoops, sweetcorn, tinned potatoes, tinned bolognese, hot dogs, tuna, mince pies, custard, chocolate coins.

We can offer food suitable for most dietary requirements.

Bar End (The Vineyard Church, SO23 9NR) - Monday 16th December and Thursday 19th December, 10 a.m. - 12 p.m.;

Highcliffe (21a Penton Place, Milland Road, SO23 OPZ) - Tuesday 17th December and Friday 20th December, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

New Alresford (St Gregory's Church, SO24 9HD) - Wednesday 18th December, 10 a.m. - 12 p.m.; Weeke (St Barnabas Church, SO22 6DS) - Thursday 19th December, 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

You will be asked to nominate which location you will be collecting your food from - please think carefully about this as we cannot change it!
