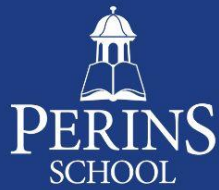
Perins Pups offers girls in years 4,5 and 6, a chance to come along and play netball in a safe and friendly environment at Perins School, Alresford.
