Keep Learning, Connect, Take Notice, Give and Be Active will be the basis of a variety of activities that the children will enjoy throughout the school day. We are excited to inform you that we will also be hosting our own Santa Fun Run in aid of Naomi House & Jacksplace as part of Elf Day. The Santa Fun Run will involve pupils and their teachers dashing around the school grounds, donning Santa Hats and have a jolly good time! £1 of your £5 donation will automatically be donated to the charity. However, if you wish to











sponsor your child more money to complete the run, please do feel free to do so. Any overpayments will automatically be donated to Naomi House & Jacksplace.

#### Christmas School Dinners & Disco-Tuesday 17th & Wednesday 18th December

It is now a SHJS tradition to arrange a Festive Lunch for our staff and pupils and we are delighted to again be inviting each class to a Phase Festive Lunch during the last week of term. The week will run like this:

- Lower School- Tuesday 17th December
- Upper School- Wednesday 18th December

The choices will be Roast Turkey and Chipolata (RED) or Parsnips and Sweet Potato Loaf Served (GREEN). Both are accompanied by roast potatoes, carrots, peas, stuffing and gravy. Dessert is a chocolate, orange and cranberry brownie or a shortbread biscuit.

The usual meal charge of £3 for a school dinner will still apply. If your child is in receipt of pupil premium funding then the charge for these meals will be applied in the usual way. If we do not receive a reply slip by Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> December it will be assumed your child will bring a packed lunch. All food orders must be made in advance and there will be no meal orders taken in class over these 2 days.

If your child wishes to bring a packed lunch from home on the day of their Phase Festive Meal they can decorate their lunchbox with festive bits and pieces (tinsel etc) so











they feel part of the occasion. For this special day packed lunch food can be especially festive but please remember NO NUTS.

The year groups not having Christmas lunch on the other 2 days will be taking lunch in their classes/wing areas and will only have the option of either a pre-ordered school picnic lunch or a packed lunch from home. The school picnic lunch will consist of a freshly made sandwich (Ham, Cheese or Tuna Mayo).

Pupils will also be invited to wear their festive jumpers on the day of their year group meal. Festive music will be playing throughout lunchtime. In the afternoon after their festive meal, the children will be able to enjoy a festive disco with their phase and teachers.
